

basketweave stitch

On the right side it looks like the half cross stitch and the continental stitch but on the wrong side, it looks like a weave which strengthens the tapestry. It requires more thread than the continental stitch.

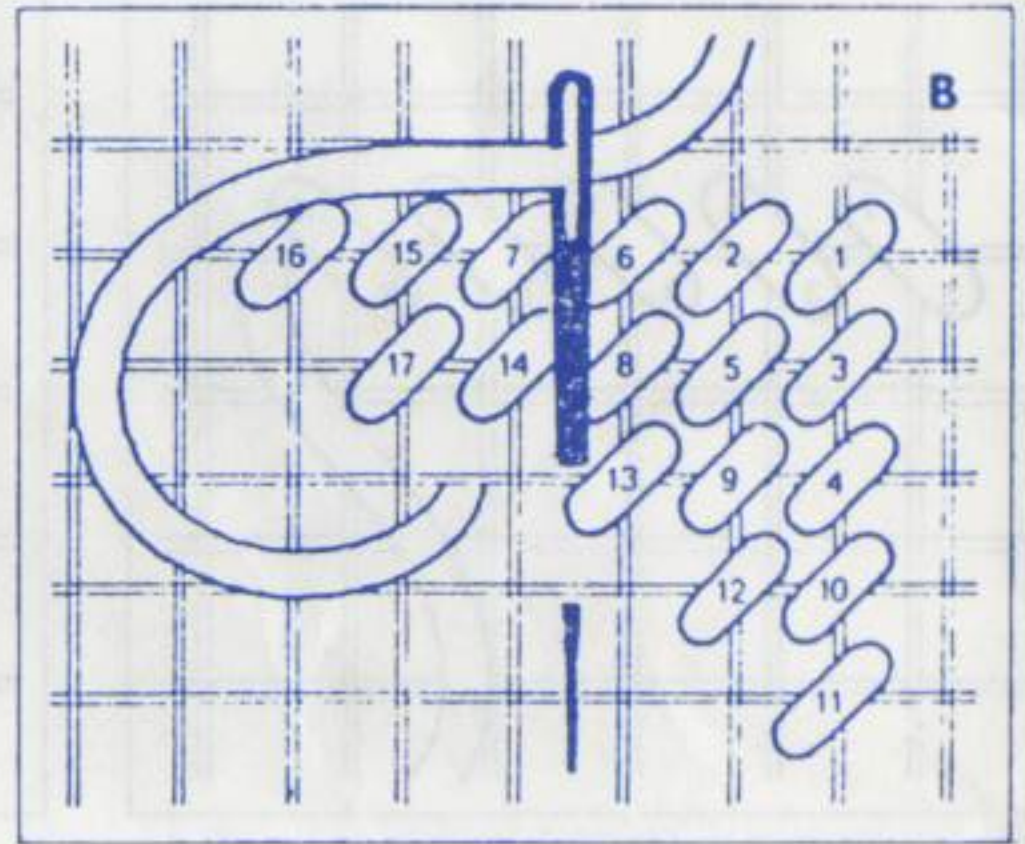
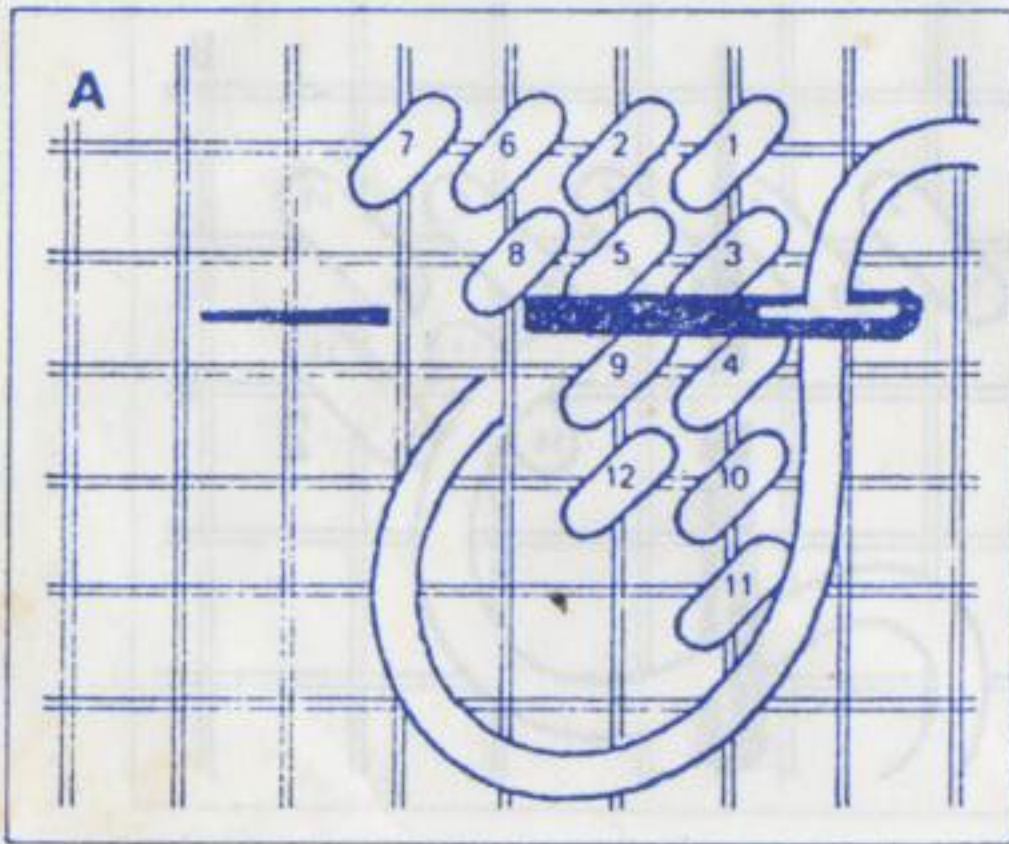
With frame. start in upper right hand corner Working on an angle, alternate a row downward working the needle vertically B and one row upward working the needle horizontally A. Each stitch fits in the gaps between the stitches of preceding rows.

Without frame same method as with a frame

With frame start in lower left hand corner. Working on an angle, alternate a row upward working the needle vertically D and one row downward working the needle horizontally C.

Without frame same method as with a frame.
