IN WINTERMAN'S

The objective of this initial exercise is to determine whether the filler tobacco used in Three Nuns can be put through a cigar making machine and that the 'rope' that is formed can be cut into flakes and that these flakes retain their shape.

Methodology

Liverpool to prepare and case 300 kilos of filler grade at a m.c. of 20%.

The tobacco to be sent to R & D by courier for onward delivery to Winterman's.

R & D will supply Liverpool with two airfreight boxes for transit.

Winterman's to be asked to thresh tobacco and run on m/c at 3 m.c.'s.

15%, 18%, 20% (ex thresher)

Winterman's thresh and dry tobacco	Wednesday
Tobacco to be run	Thursday
